NOMINATION FORM – BOARD OF DIRECTORS (JULY 2021 AGM)

Nomination Deadline: June 15th, 2021

As per the bylaws (Article III), Badminton Ontario is seeking nominations for the following Board posts:

President	2 Year Term completed in 2023
Director of Finance	2 Year Term completed in 2023
Director of High Performance	2 Year Term completed in 2023

Conditions for Nomination:

1. All nominees must be at least 18 years of age at the time of the BON 2021 AGM.
2. All nominees must be members in good standing of Badminton Ontario.
3. All new nominees must be nominated by a member in good standing of Badminton Ontario, and all nomination forms must include the written consent of the nominee. Incumbents do not require nomination by a member in good standing (BON Bylaw 4.8).
4. Nominations must be submitted to the Badminton Ontario nominating committee Chair (c/o Jeff Goldsworthy) by the nomination deadline (June 15th, 2021).
5. Unless indicated in advance, nominees should be in attendance at the 2021 BON AGM (virtually) in order to speak to their candidacy.

Nominations must be submitted on the attached Nomination Form, and must include a signature from the Nominee indicating their agreement to stand for election.

The Nominating Committee will circulate all nominations within the AGM information package.

Summary of Duties – Badminton Ontario Board of Directors:

The President – will be responsible for the general supervision of the affairs and operations of the Association, will preside at the Annual and General Meetings of the Association and at meetings of the Board and the Executive Committee, will be the official spokesman of the Association, oversee and supervise office staff and will perform such other duties as may from time to time be established by the Board. In addition, the President will be a member of the Executive Committee; will ensure a close liaison between all levels of government; will, where possible, engage the membership through attendance at Badminton Ontario competitions and functions; and will perform other such duties as may be required from time to time by the Board.

The role of Badminton Ontario President will require, on average, a time commitment of 10-12 hours per week. All expenses related to the post will be appropriately covered under the Badminton Ontario expense coverage policies.

The Director of Finance and Administration – will keep proper accounting records as required by the Act; will cause to be deposited all monies received by the Association in the Association's bank account; will supervise the management and the disbursement of funds of the Association; when required will provide the Board with an account of financial transactions and the financial position of the Association; will prepare annual budgets; and will perform such other duties as may from time to time be established by the Board. Must have accounting designation (CA, CMA, CGA).

The role of Badminton Ontario Director of Finance and Administration will require, on average, a time commitment of 10-12 hours per week. All expenses related to the post will be appropriately covered under the Badminton Ontario expense coverage policies.

The Director of High Performance – will be responsible for the coordination, development and implementation of the High Performance programs that come under the control of the association; and will perform such other duties as may from time to time be established by the Board. In addition, the Director of Coaching will act as a voting member and attend all Badminton Ontario Board of Directors meetings and will be responsible for the coordination, development and implementation of all High Performance programs that come under the control of Badminton Ontario that include but are not limited to the Quest For Gold – Ontario Athlete Assistance Program and the Canada Winter Games.

The role of Badminton Ontario Director of High Performance will require, on average, a time commitment of 4-6 hours per week. All expenses related to the post will be appropriately covered under the Badminton Ontario expense coverage policies.
