NOMINATION FORM – BOARD OF DIRECTORS (June 2022 AGM)

Nomination Deadline: May 19, 2022

As per the bylaws (Article III), Badminton Ontario is seeking nominations for the following Board posts:

Vice-President	2 Year Team completed in 2024
Director of Coaching	2 Year Team completed in 2024
Directors at Large	2 Year Team completed in 2024
Directors at Large	2 Year Team completed in 2024

Conditions for Nomination:

1. All nominees must be at least 18 years of age at the time of the BON 2022 AGM.
2. All nominees must be members in good standing of Badminton Ontario.
3. All new nominees must be nominated by a member in good standing of Badminton Ontario, and all nomination forms must include the written consent of the nominee. Incumbents do not require nomination by a member in good standing (BON Bylaw 4.8).
4. Nominations must be submitted to the Badminton Ontario nominating committee Chair (c/o Jeff Goldsworthy) by the nomination deadline (May 19th, 2022).
5. Unless indicated in advance, nominees should be in attendance at the 2022 BON AGM (virtually) in order to speak to their candidacy.

Nominations must be submitted on the attached Nomination Form and must include a signature from the Nominee indicating their agreement to stand for election.

The Nominating Committee will circulate all nominations within the AGM information package.

Summary of Duties – Badminton Ontario Board of Directors:

The Vice-President – will assist the President in the performance of duties and will be vested with all the powers and will perform, all the duties of the President in the absence or inability or refusal to act of the President. The Vice-President will be responsible for ensuring close liaison between the Association and all levels of government and will perform such other duties as may from time to time be established by the Board.

The role of Badminton Ontario President will require, on average, a time commitment of 10-12 hours per week. All expenses related to the post will be appropriately covered under the Badminton Ontario expense coverage policies.

The Director of Coaching – will be responsible for the coordination, development and implementation of all coaching programs that come under the control of the Association; and will perform such other duties as may from time to time be established by the Board.

The role of Badminton Ontario Director of Coaching will require, on average, a time commitment of 4-6 hours per week. All expenses related to the post will be appropriately covered under the Badminton Ontario expense coverage policies.

Two Directors at Large – will act as a voting member and attend all Badminton Ontario Board of Directors meetings. Will assume projects or portfolios as determined by the Board of Directors based upon programming priorities and needs. Where required, will assume responsibility for “ad hoc” or working committees struck by the Board of Directors in areas of programming responsibility. Will provide status and progress reports on determined projects as requested by the President. Will, where required, engage membership input on identified programs or projects through attendance at Badminton Ontario competitions and functions.

The role of Badminton Ontario Directors at Large will require, on average, a time commitment of 4-6 hours per week. All expenses related to the post will be appropriately covered under the Badminton Ontario expense coverage policies.
